Raw animal foods shall be separated from RTE food and from other raw animal food during storage, preparation, holding, and display. Single-use gloves shall be used for only one task and purpose and discarded when damage occurs or the task is interrupted.

Violation #54. Garbage & refuse disposal

Observed warped garbage lid that does not close -- Replace

CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5). Garbage shall be disposed of to prevent vector harborage. Trash cans will be durable, cleanable, leak proof, insect and rodent resistant, and non-absorbent. Outside storage area shall be of a smooth, non-absorbent material and sloped to a drain.
